## What Is the Church Going to Do?

Racism... Violence... Rioting... Overreaching... Overreacting... What is the church going to do in these uncertain times? While the upheaval may be new and troubling to us, this kind of mayhem is not new to the world.

The church is made for responding to this chaos and embitterment (Mt. 16:18; Eph. 2:14). She is light and truth (Mt. 5:14; Eph. 5:8; 1 Tim. 3:15). She is not of this world (Jn. 18:36; Phil. 3:20). She is eternal (2Pet. 3:10-11). She proclaims Jesus who is peace and hope.

God is concerned about the abuse of power and the mistreatment of people by people. He does, however, have a worldview which goes beyond the here and now (2Pet. 3:8). For this reason, the Son of God visited the earth, but did not end all hunger, cure all disease, nor annihilate evil. He did not force God's will upon the people. Instead, He became God's example of action through humility, love, and self-sacrifice (Phil. 2:5-11).

What is the church going to do in these uncertain times? I hope we follow the example of God's Son and...

- Seek God (Mt. 6:33; 1Jn. 1:7).
- Sacrifice self (1Jn. 3:16-17).
- Love others (1Cor. 13:4-7; Mt. 5:44; Jn. 13:34).
- Pray (1Tim. 2:1-2).
- Preach Jesus (Mt. 28:19; Acts 8:4; 2Tim. 4:2).
- Grow in Jesus Christ (Gal. 5:22; Eph. 4:1-16; 2Pet. 1:5-8).
- Hold up the truth (1Tim. 3:15).
- Shine (Mt. 5:14; Eph. 5:8, 9).
- Endure (Heb. 12:1; Rev. 2:10).
- Believe (Mk. 16:16; Jn. 3:16; 14:1; 1Jn. 5:13)
- Trust God (2Cor. 1:8-11; 2Tim. 1:12)
