## Reconciliation

When estranged friends are reunited, it is called reconciliation. We need reconciliation with our Creator because our sins separate us from Him (Is. 59:2). God desires to reconcile every person to Himself through Christ. The reconciled sinners become God's ambassadors for Christ begging the unrighteous to be reconciled to God (2Cor. 5:18-20).

Anyone can be reconciled to God through Christ. The grace of God has made forgiveness possible through faith and repentance. The repentant believer enters the grace of Christ by immersion in water for the forgiveness of sins. The reconciled remain united with God through continued obedience to His revealed word (Jn. 3:16; 8:31; Acts 2:38; 16:30-31; 17:30-31; Col. 1:23; 1 Jn. 1:7).

It's simple. It's within your grasp. However, arrogance, selfishness, and pride prevent many people from being reconciled with their Creator.... *"But they paid no attention and went their own way, one to his own farm, another to his business"* (Mt. 22:5).

Knowing that physical life is like a vapor... Knowing that eternity is forever... Knowing that each person is accountable for his deeds in the flesh, whether good or bad... *"We beg you on behalf of Christ, be reconciled to God"* (2Cor. 5:20).
