# **Prepping For Heaven**

A few years ago, a family began preparing to move to a foreign mission field. The new country had very different living conditions. This family was preparing for severe culture shock so that they might take the gospel to a Muslim country. The mother wrote about the changes her family was making in preparation for the move. She praised her family for adopting a positive attitude—looking at the move as a fun adventure. In addition, she made five points which I believe can benefit us in preparing to move from here to heaven.

- 1. **Sell your stuff.** For this missionary family the move was long-term. Our move to heaven is permanent. This family sold everything they couldn't take with them. From a spiritual perspective, "stuff" often hinders and even prevents us from moving closer to heaven. Jesus warns us that "...the worry of the world and the deceitfulness of wealth choke the word, and it becomes unfruitful" (Mt. 13:22).
- 2. **Get in shape.** Being in good physical shape helped this family overcome the stresses of moving. Likewise, Christians who pray everyday, study the Bible regularly, and immerse themselves in Christian fellowship are more likely to endure life's trials and remain in the way which leads to eternal life (Acts 2:42).
- 3. **Try new foods.** The cuisine was very different from American foods. This family began tasting a variety of new flavors and textures long before they departed. Christians who become content with the status quo may believe that they have done enough or given enough. They may refuse to try something new such as teaching a Bible class, facilitating a small group, or attending a fellowship activity. In extreme cases, they may refuse to sing new songs in worship or accept new translations of the Bible (1Cor. 9:19-23; Phil. 3:13-14).
- 4. **Turn off the A/C.** Air conditioning brings much appreciated relief to those of us living in hot and humid climates. I hypothesize that bearing the heat once in a while can be a strong reminder of why we do not want to live in "the lake of fire" (Rev. 19:20).
- 5. **Toss the appliances.** The missionary family would not have a microwave and a dryer. Accordingly, they started living without them. For Christians, sin presents itself as essential, and justifies itself as "a necessary evil." However, people moving toward heaven must toss sin out. In other words, "lay aside every encumbrance and the sin which so easily entangles us..." (Heb. 12:1).

This world is not our home. Let's start preparing NOW to make heaven our eternal home.
