Anger is a God-given emotion. It serves us well when it compels us to save others from harm. However, when we act selfishly, anger is often a source of sorrow and shame. We may say hurtful words to elevate ourselves above others or speak evil of another to win favor of our peers.

Anger ruined Cain's relationship with Abel. Without the help of bad friends, violent movies, or first-person shooter games, Cain became very angry and killed his brother Abel (Gen. 4).

No wonder the word of God repeatedly encourages us to master anger.

"He who is slow to anger is better than the might, and he who rules his spirit, than he who captures a city" (Prov. 16:32).

"Be angry, and yet do not sin; do not let the sun go down on your anger" (Eph. 4:26).

"But now you also, put them all aside: anger, wrath, malice, slander, and abusive speech from your mouth" (Col. 3:8).

"But everyone must be quick to hear, slow to speak and slow to anger, for the anger of man does not achieve the righteousness of God" (Jas. 1:19-20).

Being angry is not a sin, but unleashing our anger produces all kinds of unrighteousness. Let's renew our commit to controlling anger. Let's respond with patience, mercy, and forgiveness.
