News from Many Farms

Greetings to all the brothers and sisters in Christ from the church in Many Farms. First, we thank you for your support, encouragement and loving us as your brothers and sisters in Christ.

Due to pandemic around the world the churches have been shot down to meet by the Navaho Nation president. We have not been meeting since late March 2020. I visit the church members and give them the Bible study and worship lessons with communion packages on Fridays before the curfew. But my family worships at the building on Sundays and have our Bible study at home on Wednesday.

Some of the church members worship and do Bible study on zoom with other congregations. We worshiped with Ft. Defiance church of Christ two Sundays on Facebook.

There is a small congregation in Pinon, AZ which is about 60 miles west of Many Farms in a mountainous area. Please pray for this congregation. Recently they lost 8 family members to COVID-19.

The supplies and food were donated by a church in Tennessee. The supplies included masks, detergents, bleach, Clorox, and pine sol. The foods were mostly imperishable items—canned food, cereal, rice, beans, pasta... We were able to meet with some of Tennessee church members. We were able to deliver 37 packages of supplies to church members and other families in need.

The spread of COVID-19 is high on the Navajo Reservation, there is another 3-weekend curfew put in place by the Navajo Nation president again.

All congregations that were scheduled to come for a visit are cancelled. Please pray for the church in Many Farms that it will not lose faith. That the church will continue to grow spiritually during this hard and trying time.

We thank you again for your support whether it be monetary, clothing, prayers, or food.
