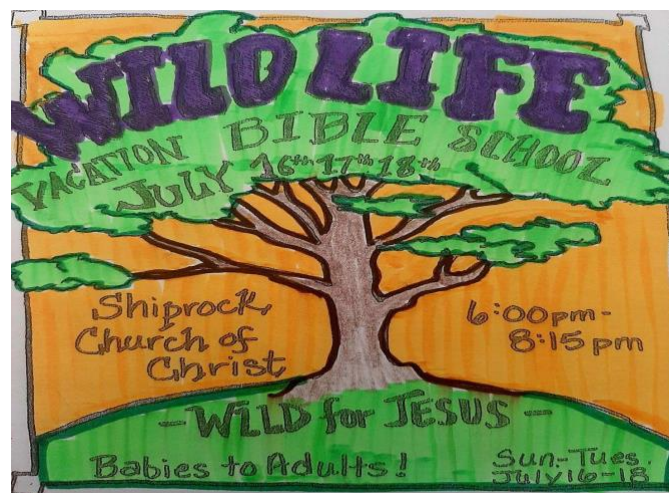

## It's Time for a Spiritual Checkup

We need annual checkups. Early detection of vision problems or blood issues can make your life better and even save your life. While many of us are diligent about our physical health, few of us give our spiritual well-being adequate attention. Knowing the eternal consequences, many Christians sense something is not quite right but fail to seek treatment.

Our relationship with God should be our highest priority. The greatest commandment is to love God (Mt. 22:36-38). Seeking first His kingdom and His righteousness carries the promise of essentials for physical life (Mt. 6:33). Relationships are healthy when they are nurtured by communication. God speaks through His written word. We communicate with God in prayer. A good measure of your spiritual health is Bible reading and praying.

The second great commandment is to love our neighbor (Mt. 22:39). The Hebrew writer marked attending congregational assemblies as crucial for spiritual encouragement (Heb. 10:25). Love your Christian neighbor with an encouraging greeting (Rom. 16:16). There is safety in numbers. There is strength in numbers. Don't make it easy for the devil. Instead, "Be of sober spirit, be on the alert" (1Pet. 5:7).

Also check your level of spiritual growth. Is your faith greater than last year? Has your love for God and people growing cold? How's your joy, peace, patience, kindness, goodness, faithfulness, gentleness, and self-control (Gal. 5:22-23)? These are reliable indicators of your spiritual health.

If staying on the path that leads to heaven is important to you, Check your spiritual health regularly.
