Repent

You can grow closer to God by becoming an avid reader of the Bible. It is a guide to making good decisions (Ps. 119:105). Following the teachings and principles of God's word results in an abundant life now and in the hereafter (Jn. 10:10).

As you read God's word, you will discover His rules for living. He gives instructions about relationships, business practices, morality, and spiritual life. You may find that you have been obeying God on a number of levels. But, at the same time you will discover thoughts and behaviors which oppose God's design and desires.

When you learn how God wants you to live, there will be a number of changes you may need to make. God is gracious and forgiving. God will completely forgive your transgression after you believe in Jesus, repent of your sins, and are immersed in water (Acts 2:38). If you continue to strive to live like Jesus lived, His blood continually cleanses you of all sin (1 Jn. 1:7). If you confess your sins, Jesus forgives any and all of them (1 Jn. 1:9).

Early Christians struggled against sins which are similar to yours—immorality, prejudices, racism, coveting, and greed. It was so bad that about 50 years after the establishment of the church, some congregations were in serious danger of losing their salvation (Rev. 2:5; 3:16). They needed to repent.

When you become aware of violating God's will, you must repent in order to be forgiven and avoid the eternal punishment. The apostles instructed erring Christians to repent (Rev. 2:5; 2 Cor. 12:21; Acts 8:22).

When you read God's word, be open to changing your thinking and living. Be ready to repent. We can't be close to God if we refuse to repent.
