Shoes

If Christians were shoes, what kind would symbolize your Christian walk?

Loafers might be lazy Christians who bury their God-given abilities and possessions. These Christians arouse the anger of the Master: "But his master answered and said to him, 'You wicked, lazy slave, you knew that I reap where I did not sow and gather where I scatted no seed... Throw out the worthless slave into the outer darkness; in the place there will be weeping and gnashing of teeth" (Matthew 25:26, 30).

Overshoes could be Christians who only seek God when it "rains." In other words, they ignore God until their earthly riches and strength fail (Prov. 3:5; 1Tim. 6:17).

High Heels might represent those Christians who think more highly of themselves than others. I can't imagine how any follower of Christ could think that he or she is walking with Jesus since he put everyone's need ahead of his own (Phil. 2:5-8).

House Shoes can signify Christians who have decided to stay home and take care of their own business. Jesus told a parable about such selfish dinner guests who gave various excuses for refusing the master's dinner invitation. The master revoked their invitations (Lk. 14:16-24). Yahweh was displeased with the sons of Israel who returned from Babylonian captivity and built their own homes but ignored building his temple (Hag. 1:9).

Dress Shoes may denote Christians who are shiny on the outside and only appear religious. Those who do religious things only to be noticed by men will receive no glory from Jesus (Mt. 6:2).

Work Shoes may come in diverse soles—old tennis shoes, steel-toed boots, Crocs... Let this footwear stand for Christians who devote themselves to developing the character of Jesus inside themselves, who are zealous for good works, and who are doers of God's word (Mt. 24:46; Col. 1:27; Tit. 2:14; Jas. 1:27; 1Cor. 15:58).
