Betrayal

Betrayal by a friend is among the worst offences. Jesus knows firsthand what it is to be betrayed. Judas, one of the chosen apostles and friends of Jesus, used insider information to hand Jesus over to His enemies. He used a kiss—the symbol of affection and friendship—to signify Jesus as the one they should arrest and kill. Even though Judas knew Jesus to be an innocent man, he took the blood money.

If there were ever a case for retaliation, Jesus had one against Judas. Let there be no doubt... Jesus chose submission and forgiveness. It was within His power to resist with the support of legions of angels (Mt. 26:53). Jesus knew that Judas was about to betray Him, and He still washed Judas' feet. Jesus was kind to Judas through the whole event.

We are called to suffer like Jesus. Sometimes, one brother mistreats another. Some may believe that there are circumstances in which retaliation is justified. However, revenge is never the Christian choice: "Never take your own revenge…" (Rom. 12:19-21).

How will you choose to respond to betrayal? Will you do as Christ did?
