Finally then, brethren, we request and exhort you in the Lord Jesus, that as you received from us instruction as to how you ought to walk and please God (just as you actually do walk), that you excel still more. Anger

Anger keeps people from obeying God's word (Acts 7:54-58; James 1:20). Anger destroys relationships and leads to murder (Gen. 4:5, 8). As the people of God, we should do everything we can to overcome the sins tied to anger.

Carry anger away from our hearts (Eph. 4:31). This Greek word can refer to carrying a dead body away and burying it away from the presence of the living (Mt. 14:12). It describes what Jesus does with our sins... "Behold, the Lamb of God who takes away the sin of the world!" (Jn. 1:29). In other words, don't hold on to anger. When we are treated unjustly and even harmed, let's carry the feelings of anger far from our hearts so that we do not respond with hateful stares, hurtful words, or vindictive deeds.

Don't hang with angry people. "Do not associate with a man given to anger; or go with a hot-tempered man, or you will learn his ways and find a snare for yourself" (Prov. 22:24-25). Hateful social media posts can inflame us to outbursts of anger. Besides blocking good sense, anger kills compassion and forgiveness. "Venting" has become the accepted social norm. However, "venting" is not of Christ. Don't let the world steal your love, joy, and peace.

Defeat anger with rejoicing, praying, and giving thanks (1 Th. 5:16-18).

Lay aside anger like those who want to free themselves for easy movement (Acts 7:58). Lay anger aside and be free to move in kindness (Col. 3:8, 12, 13).
