Why God "Allows" Suffering

Suffering can teach us a little about God's pain. How He created the perfect environment for humanity. But that was not enough for people. Eve wanted more than God was offering. She wanted to be like God, so she followed the advice of God's archenemy. Cain didn't agree with God's way, so he killed his brother who did agree with God's way. As the years passed and people populated the earth, their rebellion against God multiplied until "the wickedness of man was great on the earth, and that every intent of the thoughts of his heart was only evil continually" (Gen. 6:5). Perhaps, we don't really know suffering until we know rejection the way God knows it.

Satan lives to ruin lives (1Pet. 5:8). He is here to help whoever wants it to have more than God will allow. More money, more immorality, more pleasure, more... more... Satan presents "more" as the highpoint of peace and happiness. However, few people will admit that "more" has only led to the valley of loneliness, emptiness, and death. People suffer because they believe the lie— "more is better."

God uses everything, including suffering, to accomplish His purpose of salvation. Job's suffering typifies God's compassion and mercy (Jas. 5:11; Job 42:10). Poor Joseph had ten older brothers who hated him, wanted to kill him, and sold him into slavery. Poor Joseph was accused of rape and imprisoned. Poor Joseph was forgotten by his prison mate who was set free just as Joseph foretold. Poor Joseph eventually realized that his suffering was God's goodness toward many people. He told his brothers: "As for you, your meant evil against me, but God meant it for good in order to bring about this present result, to preserve many people alive" (Gen. 50:20).

It may be that suffering in this life is never because of God's anger or indifference. God only allows it because people have rejected His ways or because He has a plan to use evil to save lives.
