Going Backward Moves Us Forward

I'm enjoying our Sunday morning study of the Restoration Movement which began at the turn of the nineteenth century (i.e., the movement, not our study). The men who led the movement were not perfect and they did not get it all right... and the same can be said for us as we continue to work at aligning ourselves with the ancient order of things. I'm not sure that any generation ever comes to the point where they may relax and say, "We have arrived!" There is always room for improvement in our relationship with the Lord.

Restoration involves removing those things that have crept into our worship and belief system which the Lord did not authorize. So often, through the years, human innovation has had a way of being elevated above God's will. In ancient Israel, the prophet Jeremiah likened the people of God to a vineyard. The order was sent out to "Go up through her vine rows and destroy, but do not execute a complete destruction. Strip away her branches, for they are not the Lord's" (Jer. 5:10). This reminds us that whatever cannot be referred to as "the Lord's" needs to be removed. We may choose to remove those extraneous practices now... or the Lord will remove us one day from being His people.

Morally good people who genuinely love God can actually be guilty of allowing that which is not "of the Lord" to creep into their religion. The only standard we have from the Lord to determine what He wants for us to believe and practice is His book, the Bible. Thus, only by going back to the ancient order of things, will we move forward with God.
