#### All the Truth

The New Testament is the full and complete revelation of God's will. Do not be deceived by those who claim to have additional revelation from Jesus Christ.

As Jesus' earthly ministry was coming to an end, He acknowledged that His revelation was incomplete.... "I have many more things to say to you, but you cannot bear them now" (Jn. 16:12). He assured the apostles that complete revelation would come in their lifetime... "But when He, the Spirit of truth, comes, He will guide you into all the truth; for He will not speak on His own initiative, but whatever He hears, He will speak, and He will disclose to you what is to come" (Jn. 16:13).

The apostle Peter affirmed that Jesus had fulfilled His promise "...seeing that His divine power has granted to us everything pertaining to life and godliness, through the true knowledge of Him who called us by His own glory and excellence" (2Pet. 1:3).

The apostle Paul also bore witness to the fulfillment of Jesus' promise in the form of a warning... "But even though we, or an angel from heaven, should preach to you a gospel contrary to that which we have preached to you, let him be accursed" (Gal. 1:8).

In addition to these two apostles, Jude the brother of our Lord maintained that the system of beliefs was revealed in its entirety "...contend earnestly for the faith which was once for all delivered to the saints" (Jude 3).

By the end of the first century, Jesus fulfilled His promise of "all the truth." The truth was confirmed to be the word of God by accompanying miracles (Mk. 16:20). Therefore, the revelation of God's salvation through the Lord Jesus Christ has been completely delivered and confirmed. Stay away from those who claim otherwise so that you will not be deceived and believe lies (Mt. 7:15; 1 Jn. 4:1).
