

#### The Worst Could Be the Best

The worst thing that happens to you this year could wind up being the best thing to happen to you, for you are in the hands of a God who causes all things to work together for the good of those who love him (Rom. 8:28).

Being sold by his brothers was arguably the worst thing that ever happened to Joseph... "Truly we are guilty concerning our brother, because we saw the distress of his soul when he pleaded with us, yet we would not listen" (Gen. 42:21). However, by the end Joseph knew that the harm done by his brothers was for the best... "Now do not be grieved or angry with yourselves, because you sold me here, for God sent me before you to preserve life" (Gen. 45:5; 50:20).

Likewise, Jesus experienced the worst of days being betrayed, abandoned, tortured and killed (Jn. 18:1—19:30). But, the Father raised him up to be the author of our salvation (Heb. 2:10).
