What is a Q Place?

Q Place is a group of two to twelve people who come together on a regular basis to discuss spiritual topics related to life, God, and the Bible. "Q" stands for questions. It is a place where the spiritually curious can ask questions in a nonjudgmental community.

Q Place is a guided discussion of a spiritual topic. It is a safe place to ask questions and seek answers. It is led by "initiators," not experts. It uses the inductive approach rather than the traditional deductive approach. Most of us have been in a small group Bible study where an expert tells us what to believe. In a Q Place, there are no experts, and each person is engaged in discovering answers for themselves.

O Place has four core values.

Self-Discovery

People learn best by discovering the truth for themselves through discussion and study.

Safe Place

People need a safe environment for spiritual growth where personal dignity is honored and leadership is shared.

Spirit

God's spirit will guide those who are spiritually open.

Scripture

The Bible and the life of Jesus are worth serious examination.
