The Bible Only

"The Bible only makes Christians only." This phrase implies that whoever reads and follows the Bible will believe and practice the same things as every other person who reads and follows it. This principle originated during the Restoration Movement of the 1800's. Men such as Thomas Campbell, Alexander Campbell, Barton W. Stone, and Walter Scott sought to return to the Bible as the only guide for Christians. In this way there would no longer be denominations. There would simply be "Christians."

The same idea can be illustrated by grandma's cookie recipe. If all her children and grandchildren follow her recipe as it is written, each one will make grandma's beloved dessert. Following the instructions always results in the same outcome. However, if certain presumptuous grandchildren make changes to the original recipe, the result can no longer be considered "grandma's" cookies.

Over time, certain additions, omissions, and substitutions have been made to the church which God established. Some of these are clearly departures from the church built by Jesus. They simply do not match the pattern revealed in the New Testament.

God is angered by departures from His pattern (Dt. 4:2; Prov. 30:6; Rev. 22:18-19). Therefore, every generation of believers must love and seek the truth. When we follow the Bible, all Christians are united as God desires: "...so that in Himself He might make the two into one new man..." (Eph. 2:15).
