Americans grumble and complain as if it is their constitutional right. Many believe that grumbling and complaining is a constructive and healthy way of venting frustrations.

However, God has a different view of grumbling and complaining. When the Israelites grumbled against the leadership, His anger burned against them. In response to their negative words, He said, "In this wilderness they shall be destroyed, and there they shall die" (Num. 14:35).

Paul reminded Christians to learn from Israel's mistakes saying: "Now these things happened as examples for us, so that we would not crave evil things as they also craved. Nor grumble, as some of them did, and were destroyed by the destroyer" (1Cor. 10:6, 10). He also admonished the followers of Christ to "do all things without grumbling or disputing; so that you may prove yourselves to be blameless and innocent, children of God above reproach in the midst of a crooked and perverse generation, among whom you appear as lights in the world" (Phil. 2:14, 15).
