## Love

Do not underestimate the significance of love in Christian living. Here is a brief sample of its importance:

- Love is God's guiding attribute (1 Jn. 4:8).
- Love is the greatest commandment (Mt. 22:36-39).
- Love identifies the followers of Jesus (Jn. 13:35).
- Love does no wrong to a neighbor (Rom. 13:10).
- Love is more critical than miraculous powers (1Cor. 13).

Clearly, we need to give continual attention to increasing our love for God, His people, and the lost. Remember that biblical love is a decision to esteem others above self (Phil. 2:3). It is neither an emotion nor dependent upon the worthiness of the object (Rom. 5:8).

Here are a few recommendations for growing love:

- Forgive all wrongs done against you (Col. 3:13).
- Freely do acts of kindness (1 Pet. 3:9).
- Ponder God's love (1 Jn. 3:16).
