Working in the Word

Be diligent to present yourself approved to God as a workman who does not need to be ashamed, handling accurately the word of truth (2 Timothy 2:15).

Paul's words to Timothy are a call to please God by being a student of God's word. While the letter is addressed to the young preacher, Timothy (2 Tim. 1:2), it is written with the expectation of being read by the entire congregation. The last statement of the letter ends with a plural "you," indicating a larger audience than just Timothy alone.

The command to be a worker in the word of God continues to be an admonition for all followers of Jesus. God desires each one of us to devote time and energy in knowing and using His word correctly. To be diligent is to give one's steady attention and effort. To be a workman implies sweat and toil. Handling accurately denotes right and wrong ways of applying the word.

Since we desire to please God, we need to be more than casual readers of the Bible. Let's view Bible study like an occupation. Work is necessary for one's daily needs. Bible study is necessary for one's spiritual life. A person's job defines much about who one is. What does your attention to Bible study say about you?
