Why We Need a Q Place

1. The world is full of people who are lost. They will be punished in the eternal lake of fire because of their sins (Rom. 6:23; Rev. 20:15).
2. The good news of Jesus Christ can save them (Mt. 28:19-20). We have the message of forgiveness and eternal life (1Jn. 5:13). It is our moral obligation to tell others how to be saved.
