Anger

Remember how carefree childhood was? We didn't worry about taxes, the mortgage, or terrorism. We were free to play and have fun. Our parents carried the burdens of providing and protecting us.

Recently, I discovered that our Father has taken the burden of anger off of our shoulders. He takes complete responsibility for anger upon Himself. Look at what He says:

"But now you also, put them all aside: anger, wrath, malice, slander, and abusive speech from your mouth" (Col. 3:8).

"Let all bitterness and wrath and anger and clamor and slander be put away from you, along with all malice" (Eph. 4:31).

God the Father doesn't want us to be angry. He has taken that off of our plate. Anger belongs to God our Father, *"Vengeance is Mine, I will repay,' says the Lord"* (Rom. 12:19; Deut. 32:35; Ps. 94:1; 1Thess. 4:6; Heb. 10:30).

Without exception, we are to put away anger. We are not to hold on to any form of it. God has taken total responsibility even for "righteous" anger. He doesn't want us to worry with it or spend our energy on it.

Thank you, God, for taking that off my shoulders. I am free. It is fun being a child of God. Since I don't spend energy on being angry, I'll have more energy for serving, loving, and rejoicing (Galatians 5:13).
