Time to Repent

The LORD gave the Canaanites time to repent. He waited four hundred years before he gave the land to Abraham's descendants. God waited because the iniquity of the Amorite was "*not yet complete*" (Gen. 15:16). The Canaanites had plenty of time to change their lifestyle.

After four hundred years, the LORD commanded Moses to destroy all the inhabitants of Canaan because of their sins (Dt. 20:17). Even as Israel camped on the east side of the Jordan, the Canaanites had another forty years to repent while the Israelites paid for their own rebellion against God's will. Only one person took advantage of God's patience. Only Rahab believed and changed her way of life.

The Canaanites excelled in acts of cruelty toward one another. For example, the Canaanite king Adoni-Bezek cut off the thumbs and toes of seventy kings and forced them to gather up scraps from under his banquet table (Judg. 1:7). The Canaanite society was saturated with an obsession for sex. Nude statuettes of the goddess Asherah were among the commonest classes of religious objects found in archaeological digs (W.F. Albright, *Archaeology of Palestine*, p. 104). Israel's sin at Baal of Peor, also demonstrated the sexual immorality of this idol worshiping culture (Num. 25). The Canaanites sacrificed their children to their false gods (Dt. 12:13; 18:9-10).

After more than enough time, Joshua carried out the LORD's command to utterly destroy these sinful people (Josh. 6:21). God granted sufficient time for the Canaanites to change their ways.

Even now God is patient *not wishing for any to perish but for all to come to repentance* (2Pet. 3:9). Let's pray for sinful people to repent while there is time. If we are one of those sinful people, let's repent while we have time.
