Arrogance

Reading through the Bible each year has many benefits. For one, it emphasizes God's repeated warnings.

Pharaoh ruled the powerful nation of Egypt, and he was considered a god. He arrogantly refused to let God's people go (Exodus 10:3). The ten plagues targeted and destroyed Egypt. Nevertheless, Pharaoh hardened his heart. His pride prevented obedience to God's commands.

The Lord was not surprised by the hardness of Pharaoh's heart. He told Moses from the beginning that the only way this king would let Israel go was by compulsion (Exodus 3:19). However, I am surprised by Pharaoh's blatant rebellion against God's will. I wonder why he couldn't see his eminent demise and the futility of denying the Lord's power.

Arrogance blinded him, deceived him, and destroyed him. I thank God for preserving this historical event so that I might know the dangers of arrogance and take steps to rid myself of pride and arrogance.

Remember: God is opposed to the proud, but gives grace to the humble. Submit therefore to God (James 4:6-7).
