<sup>12</sup> I thank Christ Jesus our Lord, who has strengthened me, because He considered me faithful, putting me into service, <sup>13</sup> even though I was formerly a blasphemer and a persecutor and a violent aggressor. ## One Talent

Jesus uses the word "talent" to refer to money. A certain master entrusted his servants with investment capital. To one he gave five talents. To another he gave two talents, and to a third he gave one talent (Mt. 25:14).

A talent is equal to six thousand days' wages. A reasonable estimate for the average modern worker is \$80 per day. Accordingly, a talent is the equivalent of \$480,000. Thus, the first servant receives \$2,400,000. The second servant receives nearly one million dollars. The third servant receives the equivalent of \$500,000.

Each servant receives possessions "according to his own ability." Each one possesses the expertise to make a profit. The first two servants double what the master gives them. But, the third slave is lazy and foolish. He makes no effort to increase his gift.

Many of us humbly view ourselves as a "one talent" Christian. We seem to believe that God has blessed us with a meager amount. However, when we do the math, God has made even the "one talent" Christian wealthy. According to Jesus' parable, the only one who fails is the one who never tries.

We have been given spiritual gifts to produce faith, love, hope, unity, peace... The Master will return, and each one of us will give an accounting. Starting today let's seek to double the spiritual blessings we have been given.
