#### Friend

We need a friend to help us be all that we can possibly be: "Iron sharpens iron, so one man sharpens another" (Proverbs 27:17).

We need a friend who gives us spiritual encouragement. Sin is deceitful and hardens the heart. A good friend is one who encourages you day after day to be faithful to God (Hebrews 3:13).

We need a friend who speaks the truth to us (Ephesians 4:25). We need a person whom we trust to tell us when we have strayed from the righteousness of God.

We need a friend who doesn't necessarily hold the exact same beliefs and interpretations of God's word (Romans 14:1; 15:7). This might help each one of us to examine our beliefs in light of God's word. It will certainly give us an opportunity to demonstrate the love of Christ.

We need a friend who comes from a different culture and upbringing. The body of Christ should be a collection of various cultures and races and religious backgrounds (Ephesians 2:11).

We need a friend to whom we can confess our sins and will pray for us (James 5:16). This friend is going to need to be trustworthy and keep your confessions confidential.

It seems obvious to me that in order to find these characteristics, we are going to need more than one friend. Also, we need to be at least one of these types of friends for someone else.
