Destined to Fail?

Salvation through faith in Jesus of Nazareth seemed destined to fail. He was born in obscurity. He had no formal education, no military training, no wealth, and no social influence. The final nail in the coffin was his untimely death. In addition, his teachings were left in the hands of imperfect and unimpressive men. The world ferociously rejected Jesus and his followers. By all accounts, Christianity should have died out quickly.

Yet, Jesus' message of eternal life has survived, spreading throughout the world and spanning the centuries. There can only be one reason for this improbable success... Jesus is from God.

A couple of Jewish teachers recognized Jesus' origin. Nicodemus said: "Rabbi, we know that You have come from God as a teacher; for no one can do these signs that You do unless God is with Him" (John 3:2). The second was Gamaliel who said: "I say to you, stay away from these men and let them alone, for if this plan or action is of men, it will be overthrown; but if it is of God, you will not be able to overthrow them; or else you may even be found fighting against God" (Acts 5:38-39).

The Way has survived because it is backed by God. There is no other explanation. Let's continue to place our faith in God. Don't let persecution cause you to doubt the power of God to save through faith in Jesus.

As improbable as it may seem sometimes, faith in Jesus guarantees victory: "These will wage war against the Lamb, and the Lamb will overcome them, because He is Lord of lords and King of kings, and those who are with Him are the called and chosen and faithful" (Rev. 17:14).
