God's Way Matters

Doing things God's way matters. David discovered this when moving the ark of the covenant into Jerusalem. He followed the pattern set by the Philistines and set the ark on a cart (1Sam. 6:11; 1Chron. 13:7). When Uzzah reached out to steady the ark, God killed him. After a few months, David tried again, but this time according to the commands of God. David acknowledged the importance of moving the ark of the covenant according to God's instructions: *"Because you did not carry it at the first, the LORD our God made an outburst on us, for we did not seek Him according to the ordinance"* (1Chron. 15:13). Doing things God's way matters.

Let's be students of God's word so that we will know God's ways. When it comes to worship, remember to engage your heart and mind with thanksgiving (Jn. 4:24; Eph. 5:19-20). Let's build our families around the commandments of God (Eph. 5:22-33; 6:1-4; 1Tim. 5:4). Let's obey God's instruction about being saved which includes conditions such as believing, repenting, immersion, and faithful living (Mk. 16:16; Acts 2:38; Rev. 2:10).

David learned that God is serious about obedience. Let's learn from David's mistake and avoid severe consequences for disobedience... *"Not everyone who says to me 'Lord, Lord,' will enter the kingdom of heaven, but only he one who does the will of my Father who is in heaven"* (Mt. 7:21).
