Manners

Simon invited Jesus over for dinner. But when Jesus arrived, Simon was not polite to Jesus. Simon did not give Jesus water to wash His feet, a welcoming kiss, or anointing oil (Lk. 7:44-46). By withholding social norms, Simon insulted Jesus.

Christ instructs His followers to go above and beyond social etiquette. Jesus is our standard for how we treat one another. Jesus says to love one another "as I have loved you" (Jn. 13:34). He says to forgive each other as He has forgiven each of us (Col. 3:13). Manners will help us to be at peace with each other as Jesus has commanded (Mk. 9:50).
