Suffering

If God is good and all-powerful, shouldn't he be able to prevent suffering? Why does he allow suffering when it is within his power and character to prevent it? Various answers to this question have caused some people to deny the existence of God. However, such a conclusion ignores serval biblical answers and even some principles of sound reasoning.

First, God created humanity with freedom to choose (Gen. 2:16, 17). This freedom comes with consequences. Sometimes, your own choices hurt you. Likewise, your choices can hurt other people, and their choices may cause you to suffer.

Second, suffering has benefits which may not be immediately obvious. It may be God's way of testing your faith to produce endurance (Jas. 1:3). God rewards endurance (Heb. 10:36; 2Tim. 4:7-8). Often, hindsight reveals benefits of suffering. Suffering can lead to emotional and physical maturity.

Third, the world is subject to natural laws. For example, gravity keeps our feet on the ground. However, if we climb a tree and then fall from that tree, gravity may not be kind.

Fourth, certain chemicals have been proven to cause human suffering. Chlorpyrifos and other pesticides are related to a host of human illnesses. Radiation from nuclear waste can cause cancer, birth defects, and many other health issues. Poly-fluoroalkyl substances are released when firefighting foam is burned. These chemicals can cause cancer. In other words, human inventions come with a host of possible benefits and dangers.

Don't let a worldly view of suffering cause you to doubt God's goodness or even to steal your faith in his existence. Think clearly, completely, and critically.
