## **Not My Teaching**

On one occasion when Jesus was teaching in the temple at Jerusalem, the people marveled at His message because they knew He had no formal education (see John 7:14,15). Jesus answered their wondering with this response...

"My teaching is not Mine, but His who sent Me. If any man is willing to do His will, he shall know of the teaching, whether it is of God or whether I speak from Myself. He who speaks from himself seeks his own glory; but He who is seeking the glory of the One who sent Him, He is true, and there is no unrighteousness in Him" (vs. 16-18).

Like Jesus, we must acknowledge the fact that the message we preach is not from ourselves but from God. In training men to preach, I try to emphasize the importance of only speaking what God has given us to speak. Some men want the praise and glory that occasionally comes to public speakers and so they adjust the message to "wow" the masses. In other words, they speak to please men which is something that the apostle Paul absolutely refused to have said of him (Gal. 1:10). Preachers and churches who are only intent on gaining "numbers" have often changed the message of God in order to appeal to more people who do not accept the pure gospel. Some have made baptism a non-essential, since so many folks have a sectarian attitude toward immersion. Others have suggested it is all right to use the instrument in worship. even though they cannot find any New Testament authority for its use. They bring in musical instruments because that's what so many people want. Still others "water down" the concepts of divorce, homosexuality, abortion, and other sins to the extent that they are no longer considered immoral.

The message is not ours. It belongs to God. Therefore, we have no right to tamper with it. Let's just... "preach the word!"
