## Evangelizing & Discipling

Evangelism emphasizes baptism. Success or failure is determined by the number of baptisms. Missionaries have felt the pressure from supporting congregations to report baptisms each month or risk the congregation pulling its support. This pressure has left many feeling unproductive and incompetent. Which is unfortunate because we can't control when a person has a change of heart. Paul even says that conversion is not our job, but God's (1Cor. 3:6).

Q Place emphasizes discipleship. Jesus commands discipleship— "*Go therefore and make disciples...*" (Mt. 20:19). It can take years of Bible study to change some hearts. Q Place advocates personal discovery of the truth. It's not a place where you will be told what to believe and how to practice it. It is a place where biblical truth is studied and discussed. It is a place where people are allowed whatever time they need to make up their own minds if they want to follow God's word. It's a place where we practice the patience of God (2Pet. 3:9).

The three thousand on Pentecost and the Ethiopian eunuch are wonderful examples of quick conversions to Christ. It is encouraging when children obey the gospel as teenagers, and seekers are baptized after just a few lessons. Unfortunately, these are more the exception than the rule. Many conversions require time and patience.
