Assembling Together in Person

The church (*ekklesia*) is the people who have obeyed God's call to come out of the kingdom of darkness and into the kingdom of light (Acts 2:47; 5:11). God commands these believers to assemble together (Heb. 10:34). Assembling together in person is historically important (Acts 2:42; 20:7; 1Cor. 11:18, 20).

Assembling together aides in spiritual growth as we greet one another (1Cor. 16:20), serve one another (Jn. 13:14; Gal. 5:14), encourage one another (Rom. 14:19), and speak to one another in song (Eph. 5:19).

I've enjoyed worshiping from home as much as anyone. However, live streaming cannot replace the nourishment of assembling together.

God's design is for us to meet together in person until that day when we worship God face to face.
