Witnessing

Recounting the events of one's conversion can inspire others to come to Jesus. After her interaction with Jesus, the Samaritan woman told others what Jesus supernaturally knew about her (Jn. 4:29). Sharing our conversion to Christ with others may convince a lost soul to seek Jesus' saving power. This may be especially true if our commitment to Christ also enabled us to overcome exceptional addictions and sin.

The examples of witnessing in the New Testament come from eyewitnesses. In other words, they had a personal interaction with Jesus. As a result, they knew firsthand that Jesus' power and presence had changed their lives. Herdsmen witnessed demons leaving a man and entering pigs at the word of Jesus (Lk. 8:26-39). Jesus' touch healed a leprous man (Mt. 8:3). When Jesus put his fingers in a man's ears and spoke words, the man could hear and his speech impediment was removed (Mk. 7:33-35). Jesus took the hand of a dead girl and commanded her to rise (Lk. 8:54). Modern testifying does not have this same physical proof of Jesus' presence and power.

The New Testament idea of witnessing seems to be predominately that of an "eyewitness" (Mt. 18:16; 26:65; Lk. 24:48; Jn. 3:28; Acts 1:8; 5:32; 10:39, 41; 13:31). Witnessing in the New Testament is given by a person who has personally seen Jesus' power and so can give a first-hand description of it.

Paul tells of his conversion to convince others that Christ had risen from the dead. His conversion is retold several times in Scripture (Acts 9, 22, 26; Gal. 1). No one else's conversion is used to such a degree.

When we "witness" or "testify," let's keep it in a perspective which agrees with Scripture and exalts Jesus. May our testimony be humble and not egocentric. Let us share with the lost the many scriptural eyewitness accounts. May our witness compel the lost to seek Jesus so that their faith may rest on the power of God (1 Cor. 2:1-5).
