Distinguishing Faith, Opinion, & Error

The confusion about what are matters of faith, opinion and error can be clarified by comparing them to the system of belief which God has revealed (Jude 3).

If there is testimony from God in the form of a direct command, an approved example, or a statement of implication, such a belief is **faith**.

If there is no testimony for or against a particular belief and it does not violate God's word, it is a matter of **opinion**. We must allow brethren to hold their personal convictions and not require others to keep our subjective opinions.

If a belief contradicts or rejects God's testimony, this belief is **error.** It must be opposed, stopped, and repented of.

As God's children, we must continually check our beliefs to determine if they are matters of **faith**, **opinion**, or **error**. Let us have the courage to hold on to truth, to not bind opinions upon others, and to dispense with all error that may presently be a part of our faith system.
