"Be Careful How You Talk to Yourself"

"During your round, there are going to be good and bad shots and good and bad holes. Always stay positive and don't be too hard on yourself. Let go of any past mistakes; you cannot change them but can learn from them. Remember that getting angry only hurts your golf game. Positive talk, focusing on the present, and feeling confident are the keys for a good mental approach. Players who get down on themselves, or feel sorry or hopeless will not have much success.
