## Don't Take Seriously All Words

Words are powerful. The coach's words can inspire an impossible comeback. A parent's criticism can destroy a child's spirit. Words can encourage and demoralize, create faith and doubt, produce joy and sorrow. Never underestimate the power words.

People say many things without thinking. Sometimes they are just trying to be funny or fit in. Many times, our mouths are faster than our brains. I'm sure you are like me and have said several things which were thoughtless, and I wish I could take them back.

Therefore, biblical wisdom teaches us: *"Do not take seriously all words which are spoken, so that you will not hear your servant cursing you. For you also have realized that you likewise have many times cursed others"* (Eccl. 7:21-22).

True wisdom is knowing when to listen careful and when to let words go in one ear and out the other. Wisdom weighs words by their source—friend or rival... by their motivation—help or hurt... by their context—joking or thoughtful...

Our wise Father in heaven says, *"Do not take seriously all words which are spoken..."* We'd probably be happier if we listen to Him on this one.
