Believing

Believing is life. Believing the air is safe to breathe. Believing oncoming traffic will stay on their side of the road. Believing the sun will rise tomorrow morning. Believing there will be food to eat. Believing in brakes.

The stronger my belief, the greater my confidence and peace. Believing is assurance and conviction. Little faith leads to big problems like being overwhelmed by worry, fear, jealousy, and strife. Believing God is real and a rewarder of those who diligently seek Him results in confidence and peace.

We are drawn to people and things in which they believe—Ford or Chevy, Coke or Pepsi, name brand or generic. Want to be more attracted to God? Go outside and observe nature. Ask yourself, "How did all this beauty and complexity begin? By accident or by intention?" The word of God says, "For since the creation of the world His invisible attributes, his eternal power and divine nature, have been clearly seen, being understood through what has been made, so that they are without excuse" (Rom. 1:20). Then, read the Bible's record of God's love.

Believing that we are created by an eternal spirit being who is all-powerful can be frightening until we learn that He wants to have a relationship with us that resembles a father and a son. The first family walked with God (Gen. 3:8). Enoch walked with God (Gen. 5:24). He invites us to be children... "But as many as received Him, to them He gave the right to become children of God, even to those who believe in His name" (Jn. 1:12).

Believing is eternal life (Jn. 6:29; 1 Jn. 5:13). If you are having trouble connecting with God, take a good long look at your belief in God. Your connection with God is directly related to your level of believing in God's existence and love.
