#### Ears to Hear

Ears are for hearing, and hearing changes hearts. Jesus compares the struggle of changing hearts to planting seed (Matthew 13). The word of God is the seed. Different soil conditions represent different heart conditions. The road, birds, rocks, sun, and thorns are conditions which the seed must overcome to make a person fruitful to God. Every person who has ears to hear possesses the possibility of being fruitful.

Some people have been hardened by life and don't want to hear God's word. Sin has hardened some hearts so that change seems too difficult. They hear Satan telling them: "It's too hard... It's not worth it... It requires too much... It won't let you be you." If a person has ears, they can hear and change. Hard hearts can be softened by experiencing patience, kindness, generosity, mercy, and forgiveness.

Some people have a small opening into their hearts. However, their depth of understanding and commitment to truth are superficial. As soon as listening to God becomes too costly, they run away. This person has ears to hear. They can be changed by hearing God's truth. The more they hear about God's righteousness, the more they may be willing to remove sin and wickedness which prevents deeper understanding.

Some people attempt to be like Christ but worry and the pursuit of wealth keep them from whole-hearted commitment. They look like a Christian, but on the inside, they are worldly. Worry keeps them from faith in God. Wealth promises them happiness and security. However, they never seem to have enough of it to be happy and secure (1 Tim. 6:9-10).

The fourth type of heart is the only person who bears spiritual fruit. It's the heart that hears, breaks up hardness, removes sin, and overcomes worry.

This parable gives me hope because anyone who has ears may hear God's word and become fruitful to God.
