### A Learning Experience

I love a good group Bible study. Often, questions are asked which never would have crossed my mind. Sometimes, answers are expressed which challenge my core beliefs. Whichever is the case, my appreciation for God's Word grows exponentially.

I have sat in boring Bible classes. On some occasions, the teacher is unprepared or even inept. Other times, the teaching was awesome, but the students didn't participate. Perhaps, they were tired, preoccupied, or cold-hearted.

Let's strive to make the most of our time in Bible study. If you're the teacher, be prepared—study the passage, pray about it, anticipate questions and how to answer them. If you're the teacher, encourage the attendees to participate in the Bible study by asking questions (The only dumb question is the one you don't ask). View yourself and the group as students of the Word who have some answers but not all of them... not yet.

Let's endeavor to make our Bible study a learning experience. If you are an attendee, don't be passive or resistant. Be a participant—study beforehand, pray, and think of questions you could ask to spark beneficial discussion. Share your ideas and opinions in a humble and gentle way.

Our goal is to arrive at truth. We want everyone to grow in knowledge and understanding of Christ (Col. 1:28). Each one of us has skills and limitations. Together we just might overcome our personal limitations and abilities so that we arrive at a clearer understanding of God's will, love, and power.
