Who Was Jesus?

Jesus performed hundreds of miracles. These signs said something about who He was. Several opinions were offered by those who witnessed His power. Some said He was John the Baptist risen from the dead (Mk. 6:14). Others thought He was an instrument of Satan (Mk. 3:22-23). Some believed Jesus to be Elijah or Jeremiah (Mt. 16:14). An uncommon few believed that Jesus was *"the Christ, the Son of the living God"* (Mt. 16:16).

The miracles were signs from God announcing His choosing and approving of Jesus. Only a few people recognized this fact (Jn. 3:1; Mt. 14:32-33; 15:31). According to Peter, Jesus was the one whom Moses said, *"THE LORD GOD WILL RAISE UP FOR YOU A PROPHET LIKE ME FROM AMONG YOUR BRETHREN; TO HIM YOU SHALL GIVE HEED to everything He says to you"* (Acts 3:22). Peter went on to say that every person who *"does not heed that prophet shall be utterly destroyed"* (Acts 3:23).

Who do you believe Jesus was? Was He the Christ or just another man of God? Reading the signs pointing to Jesus' identity and drawing the right conclusions can make all the difference because *"every soul that does not heed that prophet shall be utterly destroyed."*
