Songs Teach

Songs are a tried-and-true method of teaching God's word. We use songs to teach young children the word of God. I particularly like the lyrics— "Read your Bible and pray every day and you'll grow, grow, grow." Below are a few examples of using songs to teach God's word to adult children.

1. Songs may warn against disobedience... *"But I will surely hide My face in that day because of all the evil which they will do, for they will turn to other gods. Now therefore, write this song for yourselves, and teach it to the sons of Israel"* (Dt. 31:18-19a).
2. Songs may educate the next generation. God inspired a song writer with this lyric: *"I will sing of the lovingkindness of the LORD forever; to all generations I will make known Your faithfulness with my mouth"* (Ps. 89:1).
3. Songs might recall God's mercy on all people: *"Therefore I will give praise to Thee among the Gentiles, and I will sing to Your name"* (Rom. 15:9).
4. God commands His people to teach each other via psalms, hymns, and spiritual songs (Col. 3:16).
5. The writer of Hebrews has incredible insight and understanding about Christ Jesus. He draws wisdom from a lyric: *"I will proclaim Your name to My brethren, in the midst of the congregation I will sing Your praise"* (Heb. 2:12).

When we are singing in our assemblies, let's remember to listen and learn.
