### **Choices & Consequences**

The basis of our choices can have catastrophic consequences. For example, Lot made a choice based solely on what pleased his eyes and thrilled to heart. He chose for himself all the valley of the Jordan because it well watered like the Garden of God (Gen. 13:10, 11).

This resulted in a series of catastrophic events. He didn't stay in the pastures but moved into the sinful city of Sodom. When King Chedorlaomer defeated the kings of Sodom and Gomorrah, Lot and his possessions were taken captive. When God's angels came to save Lot from the impending destruction of Sodom, the angels had to drag Lot outside of the city. In the evacuation, his wife died, and his daughters committed drunken incest with him. The children of incest became enemies of Abram's descendants.

You may be thinking that this is an isolated case or that Lot could not have known how things would transpire. But I propose that Lot is prime example of what happens when anyone makes a choice guided by lust of the flesh and the lust of the eyes (1 Jn. 2:16).

On the other hand, Abram became the father of the faithful. While he wasn't perfect, he did make choices which resulted in friendship with God—he sought to resolve strife as a loving and humble brother.

I hope that we have learned that it is best to base our choices on the principles of brotherhood and humility while denying the lusts of the eyes and selfishness of the heart.
