For Nothing

Would you serve God for nothing? Satan accused Job of serving God only for the blessings. Satan believed that Job was only interested in rewards for service. Satan thought that it was absurd to worship God simply because He is God. Satan was wrong. In fact, when the blessings turned into curses of loneliness, illness, and poverty, Job did not forsake God.

By comparison, Job's faith came at a time of very little revelation. He lived hundreds of years before the Law of Moses. Yet, he made the most of what he had received and left a model of faithful endurance for future generations (Jas. 5:11). His small amount of revelation proved to be enough for him to become a major example of faith.

Today, we have a full revelation of God's will—the Old Testament books, the New Testament documents, and Jesus Himself. I wonder how one of us might respond if Satan was allowed to take away our children, our health, and our wealth. With our abundance of knowledge about God and His love, would we remain faithful without the gifts? Do we love God enough to remain loyal to Him without our physical blessings?

It seems to me that Job's faithfulness (the kind which we are also to have) is not based so much on the amount of revelation as it is on the decision one makes in his or her heart. With a little revelation, Job realized that God is worthy of service simply because He is God. Do we realize that God is worthy of our devotion regardless of our physical circumstances? Would we serve God for nothing?
