Context

Some people are confused about how God saves. If they search the Bible for the answer, they may find examples which seem situational and inconsistent. In one case, Jesus tells a rich person to go and sell all his possessions, give the proceeds to the poor, and come follow Him (Mt. 19:16). On another occasion, a thief on a cross asks Jesus for salvation, and Jesus grants it (Lk. 23:42-43). Still another time, Jesus forgives a man's sin because of the faith of his friends (Mk. 2:5). Furthering the possible confusion is Jesus' teaching that people to do acts of kindness will be saved (Matthew 25:34-36). Finally, Jesus' apostles tell some people to repent and be baptized (Acts 2:37, 38).

Context is the key—who, what, why, where, and when. Readers must determine if the statements apply only to the individual addressed or has a universal application. Is this statement ever repeated to others? Does Jesus make the statement to demonstrate His deity and not necessarily to make a law for receiving God's grace? After Jesus' ascension into heaven, we have the end of the Law of Moses and the beginning of the gospel of grace. The apostles receive the Holy Spirit who guides them into all truth. From that point in time, the way to be saved is through hearing the gospel, believing it, repenting, confessing Jesus as Lord, being immersed in water, and living in the character of Jesus.

If you want to know what God requires for salvation, read the New Testament. There you will find the mind of God revealed. Remember that the Bible is like other books. It can be correctly understood when we examine it in the limits of context.
