# **Heaven Seeking**

Jesus was "different." He didn't chase fame and fortune. He didn't pick important people as friends. In fact, He spent most of His time with outcasts. He gave of Himself physically and emotionally without complaint. He excelled in obeying God's word and spent hours teaching others God's will. He prayed often. In summary, Jesus was "different" because He was seeking the glory of heaven and not the approval of men.

Which are you seeking—heaven or earth? If you are really a disciple of Jesus, you are seeking heaven. The apostle Paul words it as a command: "If then you have been raised up with Christ, keep seeking the things above, where Christ is, seated at the right hand of God. Set your mind on the things above, not on the things that are on earth" (Col. 3:1-2).

If your day-to-day living includes immorality, sensuality, strife, jealousy, outbursts of anger, disputes, envying, drunkenness, carousing, and things like these, you are not on the road to heaven (Gal. 5:19-21). However, if you are loving, joyful, peaceful, patient, kind, and self-controlled, you are moving in the right direction (Gal. 5:22-24).

Heaven-seekers are "different." They die to worldly passions and desires. They don't seek fame or fortune. They are friends with the lowly and outcasts. They are giving people. They live for the glory and will of God. They pray often and seek the eternal presence of their Creator in heaven.
