View Determines Conduct

If you see its value to you, then you will give it your attention, your money, and your endorsement. For example, parents who force their children to go to school, to do homework, to study for tests, and to attend classes clearly value education. They see the worth of good education, and it shows in their behavior.

Improve your view of God. Discover the value of knowing and serving Him. Then, your conduct, your worship, your fellowship, and your outreach will grow. The following Scriptures reveal the awesome power and glory of our God and Creator.

God's essence is spirit (John 4:24). He is not the only spirit being, but His innate characteristics elevate him above all others. He is eternal (Psalm 90:2). He has no beginning or end. While other spirit beings are eternal in the sense of having no end, they all had a beginning. At some point they did not exist until God created them.

He is infinite (Psalm 145:3). His being and characteristics are unlimited and beyond measure. All of His traits are infinite, but His endless love is truly amazing (John 3:16; Romans 5:8).

He is self-contained (Acts 17:25). God is free from the influence, guidance, or control of another. He is completely independent, self-reliant, self-sufficient, and self-supporting.

He is changeless (Malachi 3:6; Hebrews 1:12). He is the same today as he was yesterday and will be tomorrow. He doesn't act on impulses and whims. Without fail, he blesses those who obey him and curses those who disobey him.

Our God does not grow tired nor diminish in power. He exercises his greatness for our benefit (Ephesians 1:18-19).
