A Sign

Have you ever desired a direct statement from God telling you exactly what to do? When it comes to big decisions such as choosing a job or a spouse, a direct word for God seems like it would make things easier. However, we should be careful what we wish for, especially in this instance. In the Bible, direct instructions are often associated with greater hardships and accountability.

God called Abram and plainly said: "Go forth from your country, and from your relatives and from your father's house, to the land which I will show you" (Genesis 12:1). God spoke directly to Abram. He told him to leave familiar things and his family support system and to go to an unfamiliar land where he doesn't know anyone. Abram left the conveniences of city life for life as a nomad. Would you leave your family and everything that is familiar to live as a foreigner?

God spoke directly to Moses (Exodus 3), but that didn't make his path an easy one. Moses endured complaining, rejection, and death threats from God's own people. When we are hoping that God will give us a clear sign, we probably expect an easy path. We certainly don't think that His call will make us unpopular with our own family and friends.

When Jonah received a direct word from God, he rejected it and fled from the presence of God. He wound up in the belly of a great fish, vomit on a beach, and preaching to people he despised. When we think about a sign from God, I'm sure we only think about all the places we desire to visit.

Next time you're thinking: "I wish God would give me a clear sign," remember the extra hardships and accountability that accompany it. Maybe we can learn to be content with the gospel call (2 Thessalonians 2:14). The message handed down is clear and comes with plenty of challenges... "The world is passing away, and also its lusts; but the one who does the will of God lives forever" (1 John 2:17).
