Baptism

The conversions recorded in the book of Acts reveal what people did to be saved under the oversight of the apostles of Jesus Christ. These examples follow the inauguration of the new covenant of the Lord Jesus Christ. In other words, they reveal God's will for people to be saved from Pentecost until Jesus' return.

- About 3,000 people believed the gospel message, repented of their sins, and were immersed in water for the forgiveness of their sins (2:37-41).
- Men and women believed the preaching of the gospel and were baptized (8:12).
- Christ was preached to an Ethiopian man who believed Jesus Christ to be the Son of God and was immersed in water (8:36-38).
- Saul, a persecutor of the church of God, was baptized to wash away his sins (22:16).
- Non-Jewish people were baptized after hearing that everyone who believes in Jesus Christ receives the forgiveness of sins (10:43-48).
- A businesswoman was immersed after listening to Paul preach the gospel (16:14-15).
- A jailer believed the word of the Lord and was baptized (Acts 16:31-33).
- Twelve disciples of John the Baptist were immersed in the name of the Lord Jesus (19:5).

From these narratives, we learn God's plan to save all people from their sins. God offers His grace, and people receive it by obedience (hearing, believing, confessing, repenting, and being baptized). The immersion in water is the birth (Jn. 3:5). Once you are born, you begin the journey of growth and maturity in Christ (Eph. 4).

God has one plan for all people to be saved. Have you obeyed His plan? When we obey God's plan, we have confidence and peace of mind that we are saved.
