The True Israel

At one time, the physical descendants of Abraham, Isaac, and Jacob were the chosen people of God. Abraham had several children, but only Isaac was given the promises of nation, land, and seed. God blessed Isaac with twin sons, but the promises were given solely to Jacob. God changed his name to Israel and blessed him with twelve sons who became the tribes of promised nation. God distinguished the nation of Israel by the promises, the covenant of circumcision, and the Law of Moses.

The promises of a nation and a land were fulfilled by the time of Joshua (Gen. 46:3; Dt. 1:10; 26:5; Josh. 11:23; 19:51). Jesus is the fulfillment of God's promise to bless all the nations through the seed of Abraham. Jesus fulfills the requirements of the Law and makes whoever has faith in Jesus Christ a child of God (Gal. 3:23-29).

In addition, Jesus fulfills the promise to David of an eternal King and kingdom (2 Sam. 7:14-16). Jesus did not establish an earthly kingdom in Jerusalem because His kingdom is not of this realm (Jn. 18:36). Jesus is now reigning from heaven (Heb. 1:3). He will never set foot on this earth again. When He returns, the dead in Christ and the living in Christ will ascend to meet Him in the sky (1 Th. 4:13-17).

The Romans destroyed Jerusalem and the temple in AD 70 because God was finished with the physical people and location. Weeping over the rebellion of the Jews, Jesus recounted the rebellion of the Jews and the final verdict: "Behold, your house is being left to you desolate" (Mt. 23:38). There is no temple or king in Jerusalem because God's plan is a spiritual temple and king (Dan. 2:44-45; 7:13-14). Because of their rejection of Jesus, the wrath of God is upon the Jewish nation... "wrath has come upon them to the utmost" (1 Th. 2:16).

The true Israel is now those who worship God in the spirit (Phil. 3:3), and who are the descendants of Abraham through faith in Jesus (Gal. 3:7). The true Israel is no longer a physical people and king. God has given the name Israel to those who put their faith in Jesus Christ, the Son of God. We who believe in Jesus Christ are God's true Israel.
