## Opinions

Everyone has opinions. Each one of us believes his or her opinions are right, reasonable, and obvious. Your opinions are the result of upbringing, culture, education, and life experiences. Fortunately, no one is exactly the same as you.

In many situations having an opinion demonstrates forethought and intelligence. However, opinions can be harmful. Insisting that others follow your beliefs can cause conflict, hatred, and division. But, kindly sharing opinions can lead increased understanding.

Jesus recommends caution in making personal convictions the criteria for right and wrong. He says: *“Do not judge lest you be judged. For in the way you judge, you will be judge; and by your standard of measure, it will be measured to you”* (Mt. 7:1-2). In other words, if you refuse to show kindness and mercy toward others, the eternal Judge will judge you without compassion.

Jesus also points out that each person has so many misconceptions that it is impossible for one to see clearly and without prejudice. He says: *“You hypocrite, first take the log out of your own eye, and then you will see clearly to take the speck out of your brother’s eye”* (Mt. 7:5).

Let’s be more like Jesus by showing mercy to those who hold different opinions. Also, strive to evaluate yourself accurately. Your opinion may not be the best one or the right one. It certainly isn’t the only one of value.
